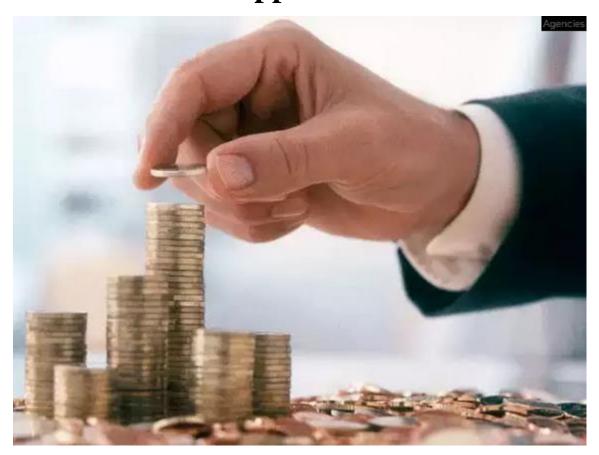

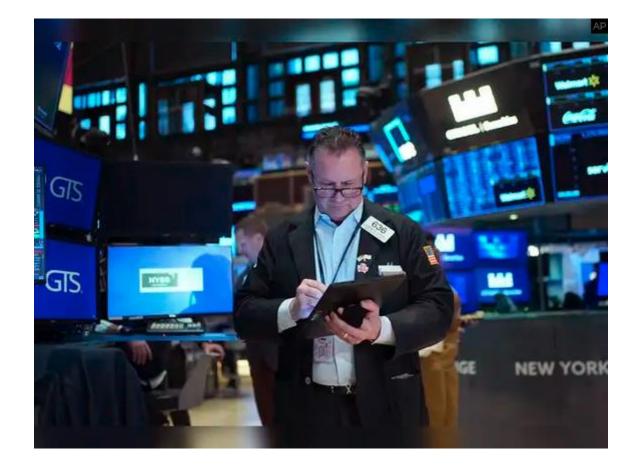
### **Tariff Concerns and Geopolitical Uncertainty**

Devina highlights her portfolio's exposure to ITC and AkzoNobel. She is cautiously adding some FMCG names as the consumption sector recovers. However, she still holds a selective view, particularly avoiding paints and real estate sectors.

Devina discusses the impact of US market uncertainty, especially due to Trump's unpredictability, on global markets. She suggests that the US may underperform in the future, opening doors for emerging markets like India and China to attract more foreign investment.
